#### Office Memorandum

Subject: Brief Overview of SNA and CNA reports - reg.

PFMS has developed various reports for SNA and CNA modules. These reports are available to different users as per the access rights. At present seven reports for SNA module and two reports for CNA module have been made live. A brief of the content of these reports is mentioned below for getting an overview .A detailed explanation of the reports is attached at Annexure I.

#### **SNA Reports**

- 1. SNA01: Comprehensive report for releases and Expenditure This report shows comprehensive details of the funds releases and utilization SLS wise in a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), the funds transferred to the SNA by State Treasury, Expenditure made by SNA and its Child Agencies, Unspent balance of SNA and Bank Balance of SNA. It helps evaluate the financial progress of a State Linked Scheme (SLS) by State as well as Central authorities.
- 2. SNA02: Agency Statement on allocation of Fund and Expenditure This report shows the fund allocated to SNA and Child level agencies for their self-expenditure and for further transfer to child agencies, expenditure made by the agencies and the limit left for allocation. This report helps Scheme Managers to monitor the financial flow in the scheme and utilization of funds by down level agencies.
- 3. **SNA03: SNA Agency mapping status** This report help Scheme Managers to monitor the agencies mapped in the scheme as SNA and child agencies. Child agencies using Zero Balance Accounts, SNA account or Parent ZBA account canalso be monitored through this report.
- 4. SNA04: Interest Income in SNA account This report shows the quarter wise interest accrued and credit date in the Single Nodal Account to assess the amount of interest to be deposited in Consolidated Fund of India.
- 5. **SNA06:** Release of Centre and State Share This report helps to get information about the delay in transfer of Centre share and State share to SNA account by the State Treasuries.
- 6. SNA09 Excess/Deficit in Treasury transfer to SNA This report shows the excess and deficit in Treasury transfer to SNA. It shows the complete GOI releases, proportionate State share, the complete Treasury release/expenditure both pre-SNA and Post SNA along with both SNA release and Non-SNA expenditure CSS wise. The corresonding SLS marked against it are also shown. The deficit report helps Center in monitoring the amount (both Center share and State Share) which has not been transferred to SNA by State Treasuries for implementation of the scheme.
- 7. **SNA10 Voucher wise Treasury Data** This report shows the details of the Treasury vouchers shared by the Treasury for a State Linked Scheme. This reportwill help State Treasuries to reconcile the data shared with PFMS.

#### **CNA Reports**

- CNA01 Comprehensive Report for Releases and Expenditure- This report shows the complete picture
  of Budget allocated to Center Sector Scheme, ExemptedReleases, Identified CNAs, Gol releases to CNA,
  Total expenditure made by CNA and its child agencies and the Bank balance in CNA account. It helps
  Program division to monitor financial progress of the Scheme.
- 2. CNA03 Status of Agency Registration This report shows Ministry wise Central Sector Schemes marked as CNA, whether operating under Model 1 or Model 2. For Model 2, it shows the details of no. of CNAs registered and the number of child agencies registered with their details. It helps in monitoring number of agencies mapped under a CNA having Zero balance Accounts and the agencies having holdingaccounts.

# A) SNA Reports

1) SNA01 – Comprehensive report for Releases and Expenditure - The report can be generated either Controller wise or State wise and is available for SNA marked CSS schemes. Report shows the releases made by GOI to States in a particular scheme, funds received by State Nodal Agency from Treasury, Expenditure and Advance booked in PFMS against the SNA Account and with actual bank balance. The report format and other details are given below:

- i) GOI Release to Implementing agency shows Release from govt. of India transferred directly to Implementing Agencies. This amount is not accounted in calculation of proportionate state share.
- ii) GOI Release to State Treasury shows Release from govt. of India transferred to state Treasury. Proportionate state share is calculated on this amount.
- iii) GOI Release to ESCROW Account shows the cases Central share is directly credited by government of India into SNA account and state share is credited by state treasury. This is included in calculation of proportionate state share but not included in the total fund to be transferred from treasury to SNA.
- iv) Proportionate State share is calculated on the GOI release by taking the average of center/state ratio defined during SNA marking.
- v) The treasury release shown contains only the amount which is transferred to SNA account. While obtaining such release, the unique code of SNA and SNA account number is validated.
- vi) Bank Balance shows the actual bank balance lying in the SNA account. Bank balance is shared by the bank with PFMS.
- vii) Column 14A shows the EAT expenditure done through PFMS portal i.e. Model 3.
- viii) Column 14B shows the DBT expenditure whether done through PFMs portal or through external system
- ix) Column 14C shows the expenditure done through external system integration i.e. Model 1, Model 2 and Model 4.

- iii) The column 'Total Amount Released by State Treasury to SNA' (column 6) shows the data received in PFMS from State treasury through treasury integration. If the data shared by treasury does not contain the unique agency code of SNA or the SNA account number, then it is not shown in report. This data is mapped with the GOI releases shown in column 4C to calculate the number of days from the GoI release after which the treasury release is made.
- 6) SNA09 Excess/Deficit in treasury transfer to SNA This report is used to calculate the excess and deficit in treasury transfer to SNA. It shows the Government of India Releases in State Treasury, Implementing Agency and ESCROW Account separately. The excess/Deficit is calculated on the basis of total release made from GOI (pre and post SNA marking), corresponding proportionate state share and the total releases by the state treasury. The report format and other details are given below:
