Action Point	Action Taken
 Every Department should identify and repeal at least 10 rules of processes and even archaic Acts, that are redundant and would not lead to any loss of efficiency. 	
 Every Department should identify forms that are in vogue and shorten them, where possible, to one page only. (Seeking of unnecessary or irrelevant information should be discouraged) 	
 Decision making layers should be reduced, to a maximum of four layers. 	
• Files and papers should be weeded out in accordance with the rules of record keeping including digitization wherever necessary.
