Subject:- Inclusion of SC/ST category and Minority community members in the Selection Boards/Committees.

draw attention directed to The undersigned is Ministries/Departments to this Department's O.M. of even number dated 8,1,2007 which was issued in pursuance of the Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for Welfare of Minorities. Para 3 (i) and (ii) of the aforesaid O.M. provided as follows:-

- The composition of Selection Committees should be representative. It should be mandatory to have one member belonging to SC/ST and one member belonging to minority community in Selection Boards/Committees for making recruitment to 10 or more vacancies.
- Where the number of vacancies against which selection is to be made is less than 10, efforts should be made to have the Scheduled Caste/Tribes officer and a Minority community officer included Committees/Boards.
- 2. A doubt has been expressed regarding the applicability of above instructions in respect of Group A and B posts. It is re-iterated that the above instructions are applicable to Selection Committees/Boards for making recruitment to Group A and B posts also. Accordingly, all concerned authorities are requested to comply with the above guidelines while making recruitment to any category of posts.
