Subject: Implementation of New Pension Scheme - Release of 2nd installment of arrears of 5th CPC recommendations to the post 1/1/2004 entrants.

Reference is invited to this Department's Office Memorandum of even number dated 17th August, 2009 wherein it was stipulated that the 2nd installment in respect of post 1/1/2004 entrants will be subject to the filling up of Physical Registration Form by the individual NPS Subscriber.

- 2. The OM dated 17/8/2009 was issued to ensure that subscribers fill in the Physical Registration Form so that the basic data viz. name, age, date of birth, address, etc. are updated in the PRAN account maintained by NSDL so that their PRAN Account gets activated. It is presumed that Physical Registration Form would have been filled up by now
- 3. The 2nd installment of arrears on account of implementation of revised pay scales on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission may be released to all the post 1/1/2004 entrants straightaway.
