Sub:- ICAR Sports Tournaments- Revised Guidelines – Regarding.


Sir,

On the recommendations of the Standing Central Sports Promotion Committee of ICAR and in supersession of the earlier office letters in this respect, the approval of Competent Authority is hereby conveyed for revision of the following provisions for improvement of ICAR Sports:-

Sl.No.	Existing Provision	Amended Provision
1.	To enhance the rates of lodging charges as Rs.125/- per day for A-1 cities, Rs.90/- per day for A&B class cities and Rs.60/- per day for C and other unverified cities.	The rates of lodging charges will now be Rs.400/- per day for A-1 & A class cities; Rs.350/- per day for B Class cities; and Rs.300/- per day for C and other cities.
2.	The concept of incidental charges has been removed. Only DA is allowed on the basis of the absence from Hqrs. on calendar day basis i.e. from midnight to midnight. Hence DA has been substituted in place of Boarding charges. The DA has been allowed as per the class of city i.e. for A-1 @ Rs.200/-, for A-Class @ Rs.160/- and B-1 and expensive location is @ Rs.130/- and for other location is @ Rs.105/-	An amount of Rs.350/- will be paid as DA inclusive of Refreshment Charges and no separate refreshment charge will be paid to the players. These rates will be applicable in respect of all cities.

3.	To travel by second class sleeper in respect of players for ICAR Zonal Sports Tournament and Inter Zonal Sports Final Tournament.	To travel by 3 tier AC in respect of players for Inter Zonal Final tournament only subject to availability of tickets.
4.	The list of games are in approved guidelines as mentioned vide File No.6-2/81-Estt.V dated May, 1983.	The game "Pole vault" is substituted by "Basketball" from the list of sports events as mentioned in guidelines vide F.No.6(2)/81-Estt.V dated May, 1983.
5.	Kit items including track suit may be provided to the selected players for the zonal tournaments within a consolidated amount of Rs.1800/- per participant as a maximum ceiling. No separate kit may be provided when the gap between the tournaments is less than three months i.e. 90 days. Not more than one track suit is to be provided in period of 12 months. The equipment items shall be separate as usual and subject to actual need and kept as a sports stock at the institute for usage as per its normal prescribed life span.	The maximum ceiling of kits enhanced to Rs.2200/- per participant. All other conditions remain the same.

The above provision would be effective from the date of the issue of this letter.
