JIRCAS Visiting Research Fellowship Program

JIRCAS, through international collaborative research, one of the schemes of its main activities, aims to provide scientific solutions to the various problems confronting the countries in the developing regions of the world, particularly in the areas of agriculture, forestry and fisheries. In line with this scheme, JIRCAS launched the JIRCAS Visiting Research Fellowship Program in 1992. Since then, every year, JIRCAS invites promising researchers from research organizations in developing countries to conduct research work under the supervision of JIRCAS researchers.

This fellowship program has two types namely, 'Tsukuba-Okinawa' and 'Project Site'. This year, however, there is no call for applications for 'Okinawa' fellowship. Researches under the 'Tsukuba' type will be carried out at the JIRCAS Headquarters in Tsukuba, and those under the 'Project Site' type, at the research institutes in the developing countries where JIRCAS collaborative research projects are being implemented.

This year, five (5) researchers will be awarded the Tsukuba Fellowship, and one (1) researchers, the Project Site Fellowship.

The JIRCAS Visiting Research Fellowship Program aims at the promotion of international collaborative research to address various problems confronting countries in the developing regions on a global scale, including the critical situation of food production, the progression of desertification and the gradual disappearance of genetic resources.

This fellowship program has two types: (1) Tsukuba-Okinawa (2) Project Site. Under the Tsukuba-Okinawa fellowship program, JIRCAS invites qualified researchers from research institutes/universities in developing countries to carry out collaborative research for the rapid and sustainable development of agriculture, forestry and fisheries compatible with the preservation of the natural environment. This year, however, the call for applications for the former type is open only for Tsukuba. Researches will be conducted at the JIRCAS Headquarters in Tsukuba.

Upon return to their home countries, the fellows are expected to play a major role in the activities of their respective institutions, and work towards the achievement of the fellowship program's goals.

Slots available

Five slots; one for each research theme

Tenure

The fellowship covers a period of one year starting from October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014

Benefits

- 1. A round-trip airline ticket (economy class) (not available for dependents)
- 2. Living allowance: ¥7,700 per day (excluding housing allowance)
- 3. Housing:
  - a. Allowance: Based on the regulations for government housing
  - b. Facility: Tsukuba International House

 Insurance: Overseas travel accident insurance package for injury, sickness and damage (dependents not covered)

#### Qualifications

- 1. Be a national of a developing country.
- Be currently employed in a research organization or university in the applicant's home
  country where he/she is actively engaged in research relating to agriculture, forestry and
  fisheries. After the completion of the Fellowship, he/she must be willing to return to
  his/her country to continue to carry out research at the same research institute or
  university.
- 3. Should be endorsed by the authority of the institution where the applicant is employed.
- Hold at least a Master's degree in a field relating to socio-economics, natural sciences
  or technology.
- 5. Should be in good health.
- 6. Have an adequate command of English and/or Japanese language.
