Chaman,

Ministry of Finance has been repeatedly emphasizing upon the importance of the prudent expenditure management for achieving an even pace of expenditure throughout the year and necessity to curb rush of expenditure in the last quarter of the year particularly in the month of March.

- This Ministry had also issued instructions vide OM No.21(1)-PD/2005, dated December 27, 2006 reiterating strict adherence of instruction issued on monthly expenditure Plan/Quarterly Expenditure Allocation in respect of Demands for Grants which are covered by the Modified Cash Management System during the last quarter of the Financial Year. Hon'ble Finance Minister in his meeting with the Financial Advisers held on 29.10.2010 has inter-alia reiterated that parking of funds and year-end rush of expenditure has to be avoided.
- It is, therefore, reiterated that the expenditure in the last quarter of the current financial year should not exceed 33% of the budgeted amount and the expenditure during the month of March, 2011 should be limited to 15% of the Budget Estimates. Where the Revised Estimates for 2010-11 are lower than Budget Estimates 2010-11, actual expenditure may be kept within RE ceilings. It is also clarified that these instructions are not applicable in respect of only the schemes for which cash additionality has been included in the third batch of Supplementary Demands for Grants 2010-11. Compliance of the above instructions is being monitored at the highest level in the Ministry of Finance. You are, therefore, requested to enforce compliance on the above instructions without any deviation.
