ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred by Central Government <u>vide Notification No. 1520(E) dated 20th October, 2005</u> of the Ministry of Labour and Employment the undersigned orders the payment of Variable Dearness Allowance to the workers <u>employed in Agriculture w.e.f. 1-10-2009</u> on the basis of the average of All India consumer Price Index for Industrial workers reaching 468.83 from 454.17 as on 30-6-2009 (Base 1982=100) and thereby reultiling in an increase of 14.66 points. The revised Variable Dearness Allowance as under would be payable from 1-10-2009:-
