It is for the information of all prospective candidates who have appeared in CUET (UG) 2026, conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), and who have passed Class XII/Intermediate with at least three core subjects among Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, and Agriculture/Inter-Agriculture, and are desirous of participating in the counseling process for admission to undergraduate programmes in Agriculture and Allied Sciences under the ICAR All India Quota (AIQ) seats for the academic session 2026–27. Admission under the ICAR AIQ seats shall be offered to 13 undergraduate programmes in Agriculture and Allied Sciences available at State Agricultural Universities, Central Agricultural Universities, ICAR Deemed-to-be Universities, and Central Universities having Faculties of Agriculture. The CUET (ICAR-UG) 2026 Information Bulletin, containing details of participating universities, 12<sup>th</sup> standard subject eligibility for the respective program, tentative seat availability, and programme-specific instructions for Agriculture and Allied Sciences, is available on the ICAR website ([www.icar.org.in](http://www.icar.org.in)). The ICAR UG Online Counseling Brochure-2026, containing detailed information on the counseling process, rules, guidelines, and the final seat matrix, will be hosted on the counseling portal (<https://icarcounseling.com>). The counseling portal will be made operational after the declaration of the CUET (UG)-2026 results by the NTA. Thereafter, interested candidates may visit the portal for registration, rank generation, choice filling, counseling, seat allotment, and other related activities. For PG and Ph.D. candidates the counseling activities will be available after declaration of result of their respective entrance examinations by the NTA. All candidates are advised to regularly visit the counseling portal and remain updated with the latest information and announcements regarding the counseling process.
