

Report of Swachh Pakhwada dated 30.10.2016 & 31.10.2016 (period 16-31 October, 2016)

The ICAR Headquarters, all 103 ICAR Institutes and all the 648 KVKs all over the country are observing Swachhta Pakhwada during 16th – 31st Oct 2016. During this period both the on campus and off campus cleanliness activities have been planned involving ICAR Scientist /Staff/ Students/ Farmers/ common citizens. Various establishments are conducting Swachhta Seminars, Awareness campaigns, Melas etc. on relevant topics.

Report on the activities:

30.10.2016 & 31.10.2016

- At-ICAR- Central Institute for Research on Cotton Technology, Mumbai is celebrating “Swachhta Pakhwada” during 16-31 October,2016 as part of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan Programme An interactive section was organized on dated 31.10.2016 from 3.00 P.M. to 4.00 P.M. in the Jubilee Hall on “ Happy Thought ” by Shri Mohan Gupta (Tej Gyan Foundation, Mumbai) at ICAR- Central Institute for Research on cotton Technology , Mumbai About 70 employees attended this proppramme.
- Under the campaign of Swachhta Pakhwada on 31.10.2016, cleaning of KVK farm activity was conducted at KVK, Mahasamund farm by Indira Gandhi Krishi Vishwavidyalaya, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Mahasamund (Chhattisgarh) with involvement of farmers and farm women of the Bhalesar village. Shri Kunal Chandrakar, Subject Matter Specialist (Soil Science) motivated the farmers and farm women to keep their house and nearby farm/badi area clean. He also explained the importance of cleaning farm waste and how to make NADEPH compost. During this two NADEPH was also filled. This way villagers got practical demonstration also.

(a)Importance & objectives of Swachhta Pakhwada, b) Personal hygiene (c) Importance of construction of toilets at home (d) Recycle of farm waste by improved composting method (e)Management of non bio-degradable materials (f). Positive thinking & its effect on social life.
- At Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Tanuvas, Namakkal:Composting methodology was demonstrated at Ganganaickenpatti village, Mohanur Block. Methodology for composting of organic manures, plant residues & coir pith was demonstrated to farmers in heap method at Ganganaickenpatti village, Mohanur Block. 10 people were participated. Also created awareness among the farmers about purpose of decomposition and its application to field.

Farmers were educated about the health hazards of open air latrine. Farmers were encouraged to wash hand prior to having meal as this practice can rid them from numerous diseases (diarrhoea, stomach infections, worms etc).

Farmers were advised to throw their household garbage at a particular place and dump it. Further they were suggested to prepare some bio-fertilizer out of this household garbage and use it in agriculture. Cattle litters were advised to accumulate for the use of Gobar Gas and preparation of Farm Yard Manure. In Kathrain village programme was organized at Govt. Primary School, Kathrain (Kaler). Children were educated about cleanliness and their benefits. First of all emphasis was given on using Sauchalaya. Encouragement was laid on washing hand prior to having meal as this practice can rid them from numerous diseases (diarrhoea, stomach infections, worms etc).
